THE BIG BETS FOR YEAR THREE (April 2022 – April 2023)



- Leverage seamless and holistic advising practices across secondary and postsecondary as a core strategy to helping students explore, choose, pursue, and persist in the career pathway of their choice by supporting MyCAP implementation in grades 7–12 by June 2023.
- Design and implement high-quality career exploration experiences in grades 7–12 so that students have participated in at least two career exploration experiences by June 2023.
- Develop a strategic plan for innovation & early college pathways implementation in BPS, with an assessment tool for schools to determine their readiness for implementation.
- Increase systems alignment between Bunker Hill Community College and UMass Boston, including admissions, holistic advising frameworks, and data systems, resulting in a draft multi-year plan for implementation by June 2023.
- Through the Data Working Group, ensure partners can leverage available data to support and monitor students' progress through and success in pathways across secondary and postsecondary levels.
