THE BIG BETS FOR YEAR FOUR (April 2023 – April 2024)

- Create visual pathways for students and families so that all students understand which credentials and programs lead to high-wage, high-demand careers in target sectors.
- Engage with employers in a deeper, more meaningful way to expand work-based learning and pathway opportunities for all students to seamlessly engage in career exposure and experiences from high school into postsecondary programs.
- Innovate within current advising supports and systems to access and reach more students with the support they need for successful transitions from high school to postsecondary education and persistence to completion of degree or credential.
- Improve and/or expand summer programming to address summer melt so students are more likely to enroll and have a successful transition.
