THE BIG BETS FOR YEAR FIVE (April 2024 - April 2025)

Leverage seamless and holistic advising practices across secondary and postsecondary to help students succeed in the career pathway of their choice.

Design and implement high-quality MyCAP experiences in grades 7-12 so that students participate in at least one MyCAP scope and sequence experience annually by June 2024.



Implement dual enrollment experiences in SY 24-25 that can build towards early college pathways.

Increase high quality work-based learning experiences in secondary and postsecondary, measure progress on student participation with disaggregation for demographics and BPS graduates (at postsecondary level), support increased employer engagement along the education continuum.

Advance the enactment and implementation of new city and state level policies that maximize equitable student degree completion and career outcomes through cross-sector efforts.
